LIVE LIFE YOUR WAY.


Whatever you love doing in life, Casterbridge Court will help you to take full advantage of everything the town and the surrounding area has to offer.

The Borough Gardens and Salisbury Fields are also a delight. With their play parks and open spaces, they are adored by local and visiting children alike. Throughout the spring and summer months, the Borough and nearby Maumbury Rings host festivals and events including live music and open-air theatre. Anyone who enjoys a leisurely stroll should head to the banks of the River Frome with its lovely views across the water meadows.

The surrounding area has much to offer too. Nearby is Poundbury, the eco-friendly town created by Prince Charles. Just down the road is the opulent Grade I listed Athelhampton House with its award-winning garden.
