




The town retains many architectural gems from the past. The oldest building is the Church of St Mary, built by the Knights Templar. Baldock also has a lively social, arts and sports scene.


There's a museum, library and community

centre. The town also hosts numerous events throughout the year. The largest are the cultural Baldock Festival, the Annual Beer Festival, The Charter Fair which dates back to 1199 and Balstock Music Festival which has over 200 artists performing across 13 stages.

For anyone who enjoys keeping fit, there's an excellent sports centre and nearby North Herts Leisure Centre with a pool. There are also various Golf Clubs nearby, including Letchworth Golf Club just 2.8 miles away. Baldock has many green spaces for leisurely afternoon walks, and the surrounding countryside has plenty of footpaths to explore. There are also historic places to explore including beautiful Knebworth House only a short drive away.

The town has excellent travel links. Catch a train from Baldock station and you'll be whisked to London King's Cross in just 40 minutes. Cambridge is only 25 minutes away by train. The A1 is close by, so getting to Cambridge, Bedford or Hertford couldn't be easier. There's an excellent bus service too. For trips further afield, Luton airport is just over 30 minutes drive.

What's more, you don't need to wrestle with a lawnmower or pick up a fork to keep this space looking picture perfect. We take care of all the outside spaces for you.






